

# Chair - Financial Services Consumer Panel

The Financial Services Consumer Panel (FSCP) is an independent statutory body. Its job is to influence the way the consumer interest is incorporated in the development and implementation of financial services regulation. It does this by advising the Financial Conduct Authority (FCA) on its policies and practices, and on its effectiveness in delivering good outcomes for consumers.

As Chair of the FSCP, you will be the public face of the Panel, leading and giving strategic direction. You will lead the development of the Panel's work and ensure that performance goals are met. You will represent the Panel's views to the FCA Board and to senior staff within the FCA and will also represent the Panel outside the FCA.

Such a high-profile role requires high-level leadership experience. It is vital that you have an informed understanding of financial services and consumer issues, including the needs of different types of consumers in this area. It is also essential that you possess the gravitas to operate under close public scrutiny and have a balanced approach with excellent relationship building skills. You will already have experience of working on a Board or Committee, perhaps as Chair. You will probably also already have experience of high level discussions with Government or other decision-making bodies. An appreciation of the role played by regulation would also be extremely useful.

Panel members act in a personal capacity and do not represent particular sectors or interest groups but must be committed to helping consumers get a better deal from the industry and regulatory system.

As the Chair of the Panel you can expect to work 20+ hours per week. For this a remuneration of £60,000 per annum is paid accordingly.
